	Holly Johnson has worked with us for 6 years in many different roles! She has two children who attended our setting a long time ago!

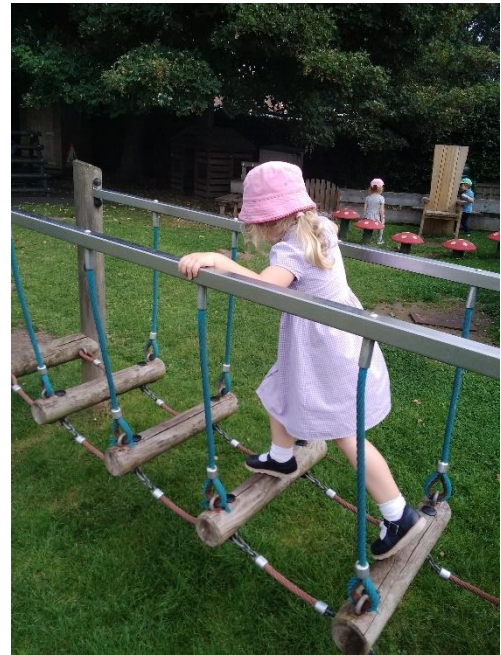
Contact

Fees and Payments

per session

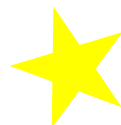
After School Club:

Payments can be made in cash and given to staff at the main office, by bank transfer or through your government tax-free childcare account. You will be given a leaflet explaining how to pay using this method when you register with us.



Booking a Place

Please inform us as soon as possible if you would like to book a place at either of our clubs. Mrs Hymers or Miss Bond can allocate your child a place and this will be guaranteed for their entire time with us. If you are looking to change your days and add/remove any, please be aware that we may not always be able to provide these as our clubs are very popular. We are able to have 16 children at any one time. If there are no spaces available, we can add your child's name to a waiting list in case a space becomes available.



Drop off/ Pick-up

- Please make sure you enter and exit the building promptly. If you need to speak to a staff member for longer than a couple of minutes, please book an appointment via the office.
- Please come to the main school doors and ring the bell. A staff member will come to let you into the building.
- Children can only be collected by an authorised person on their registration forms. If you need someone added to the list, please speak to staff at the main office. As a one-off, if you require someone different to collect your child, please phone us to let us know. The adult (over the age of 16) will need to give us their full name and show ID, and tell us the password on the registration form.



Curriculum

Little Stars is an extension to your child's Nursery day. We will deliver the same fun Early Years curriculum and ensure your child has a great time, indoors and outdoors. Both clubs are run in our school hall. Food is served here and also activities are set up. Children will have access every session to outdoor play, and also soft play where possible.

We like to follow child's interests to make our sessions as enjoyable as possible as well as following topic based learning.



Absence

If your child is going to be off Nursery for any reason, please inform the main office via telephone call or email. You will still be charged for any wraparound sessions that have been booked.

If you have a pre-planned holiday-please let us know at least two weeks in advance and you will not be charged for this.



Additional Needs

Children with additional needs are welcomed into our wraparound clubs, just as they are in our Nursery. We pride ourselves on managing children with additional needs and creating excellent family relationships. If you have any concerns about your child's development, please speak to your child's key person in Nursery, or Mrs Lowes or Mrs Richardson would be glad to assist where they can.

The Nursery SENDCo (Special Educational Needs Co-ordinator) is Mrs Hymers. She is responsible for ensuring all children's needs are catered for including requesting additional support or resources when needed and completing support plans for some children.



Medical information

All of our staff hold a paediatric first aid certificate and this is renewed every three years. If your child has a medical condition, please ensure this is written in your registration pack. The wraparound staff may need to discuss this further with you and in some cases come up with a medical care plan.

Our staff are trained to deal with any minor cuts, bumps or scrapes. For anything more serious (eg a suspected broken bone, or something requiring stitches) we would notify a parent immediately.

For something serious which requires immediate medical attention, the following actions are taken:

1. 999 are phoned
2. Parents (or emergency contacts) are then notified

If your child receives regular medication (or needs it as a one-off) there will be a form to fill out. Staff can give medication only as stated on the packet/bottle. All medicines must be brought in with the prescription label on otherwise these will not be accepted.

If your child has an allergy, this also needs filled out in the registration pack. Staff will discuss this with you and we will ensure that our menu caters for these needs.

If your child is unwell, we may phone you to come and collect your child early. If they are vomiting or have diarrhoea, they will need to be off nursery for 48 hours. You are welcome to phone the nursery if you are not sure if your child needs to stay off or not.

Safeguarding



All of our staff receive regular safeguarding training to ensure we keep our knowledge up-to-date. If we have concerns about a child, we would discuss this with the parent (where it is safe to do so) and may need to take this further by phoning First Contact, a team responsible for child protection within Durham.

If you have any concerns about a child, you can phone First Contact on 03000 267 979

Our safeguarding lead in school is Mrs Hymers, or if she is not available Mrs Lowes.



Behaviour

In the Early Years Foundation Stage, children are still learning about boundaries and what is acceptable in terms of behaviour. We teach tolerance and patience to help our children develop into kind and well behaved members of society. We aim:

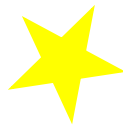
- To promote positive behaviour
- To provide a harmonious, fair, consistent and safe environment for all
- To provide an environment where effective teaching and learning can take place
- To help children feel good about themselves and achieve their potential taking into account a child's stage of development and emotional needs.
- To encourage self-discipline and help children to make positive choices and develop an understanding of the impact of their behaviour on others



All children will be encouraged and supported to enable them to:

- Follow adult directions
- Move around the setting safely and appropriately
- Respect themselves, other people and the setting environment
- Make informed choices developing an understanding of their impact on others
- Not hurt others physically or verbally
- Speak kindly to others.
- Always walk inside.
- Look after and use appropriately, the equipment both inside and outside.
- Share and take turns.

Where issues do arise we will work together with parents to discuss any behavioural need and to find ways to improve it.

Tuesday	Choice of Cereals/Porridge/ Ready Brek served with wholemeal toast, seasonal fruit and fresh juice/milk	Make your own wraps, ham, chicken served with seasonal vegetables
Wednesday	Choice of Cereals/Porridge/ Ready Brek served with wholemeal toast, seasonal fruit and fresh juice/milk	Beans on wholemeal toast served with mixed salad
Thursday	Choice of Cereals/Porridge/ Ready Brek served with wholemeal toast, seasonal fruit and fresh juice/milk	Make your own sandwiches, tuna, sweetcorn, cheese served with seasonal vegetables
Friday	Choice of Cereals/Porridge/ Ready Brek served with wholemeal toast, seasonal fruit and fresh juice/milk	Cheese and selection of crackers served with seasonal vegetables



Termination of contract

We reserve the right to terminate a place at our wraparound clubs due to:

- Non-payment or continual late payments
- Lack of compliance with policies
- Lack of parental co-operation/ disrespect
- Failure to complete or return required forms
- Physical or verbal abuse to any person
- Continual disciplinary problems
- False information given by any parent verbally or in writing

If your child's place is terminated and there is money outstanding, a bill will be sent along with your letter of termination.
