This year we have not grouped the children to allow greater flexibility for parents.

You are invited to come to watch one of the performances.

There are to be no photos or videos taken during the performance, but there will be an opportunity at the end for you to spend time with your child in their costumes so that you can take some photos of them alone.

Your child will only perform in the slot that you have booked to watch. If you are unable to come to either performance, your child will not take part in either.

Relaxed Performance

If you feel that your child may be overwhelmed performing in front of lots of grown-ups, we are offering a more relaxed event on **Wednesday 10th December at 9.30am**. This will include:

Important Reminder

Santa's Grotto Visit

Children will be visiting Santa at Spennymoor Town Hall on **Thursday 4th December**. We have different slots to choose from and parents are welcome to come, or if it is your child's usual session, staff are happy to take them.

If your child usually attends on a Thursday, staff will take them down for either a slot at 10am or 1.30pm (ask your child's key worker which slot your child will be attending).

If your child does not attend on a Thursday, you can meet us there for another slot at 10.30am.



Our three and four year old children will be walking down- if you think your child may struggle, you are welcome to meet us there with them.

The Clumsiest Christmas Elf performance

We have invited a theatre company in to Nursery do a mini-production for the children on **Tuesday 9th December at 9.30am** lasting around 45 minutes.



They have been in to perform in previous years and have been a real hit with the children, we're sure this year will be just as good! If your child does not attend nursery on a Tuesday, they are still welcome to come along! Chat to Erin to book them in for free and find out the timings.

Building work

Our builders and gardeners will be in the two-year-old garden during the week of 10th November. A new larger play space is being created with a new fence, all new flooring, and equipment. We are also getting a new fence and some tree stumps removed in the planting area. The garden will be closed to all two year old children during this period and so they may have to share the three-year-old garden.

Christmas Jumper Day

This will take place on **Thursday 11th December** in line with 'Save The Childrens' annual event. Children are welcome to wear a Christmas Jumper / T-shirt or non-uniform if they prefer. Donations are welcome and all proceeds will go to Save the Children. To make it even more festive, we will

have our Christmas dinner on the same day. If your child normally has a hot dinner on this day, they will automatically get one- if your child does not usually but you would like them to have one, please book with Erin for a cost of £3.00. Unfortunately, if your child does not attend on a Thursday, they will not be able to come in as an extra due to ratios and hall space for lunches.

Party day

This year's Christmas party day will be on **Wednesday 17th December**.

Children can come in wearing their party clothes— but please remember to still bring a coat and sensible shoes in case we go outside! If your child does not attend on a Wednesday, they can still come and enjoy the fun from 9am to 12pm.

Snack Donation



We will also be running a chocolate and bottle tombola. If you have any chocolates, sweets or bottles that you would like to donate, please




School Places
